

## AFIRMÓ SU ROSTRO / JESÚS RESOLUTELY SET OUT

Luke 9:51

<sup>51</sup> As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem”

<sup>51</sup> Cuando se cumplió el tiempo en que él había de ser recibido arriba, afirmó su rostro para ir a Jerusalén”

**INTRO:** Did you ever had a determination of doing something? It didn't matter if your parent, family or friends would tell you: "You can't do it", "It's not possible" or "No one has ever done it". You had a purpose, you were able to find that will of power and the strength to be able to accomplished what you had resolved to do. It was your determination. Jesus resolutely set out to do what He was sent to do!

### I. THE DETERMINATION OF JESUS

#### 1. It began in the heavens

1) Is. 6:8 <sup>48</sup> Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!" <sup>48</sup> Después oí la voz del Señor, que decía: ¿A quién enviaré, y quién irá por nosotros? Entonces respondí yo: Heme aquí, envíame a mí”

#### 2. It was announced before His birth

1) Mat. 1:21 <sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.” <sup>21</sup> Y dará a luz un hijo, y llamarás su nombre JESÚS, porque él salvará a su pueblo de sus pecados”

#### 3. It was in him since he was young

1) Luke 2:49 <sup>49</sup> And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" <sup>49</sup> Entonces él les dijo: ¿Por qué me buscabais? ¿No sabíais que en los negocios de mi Padre me es necesario estar?”

#### 4. He set his mind to do it

1) Luke 9:22 <sup>22</sup> saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day.” <sup>22</sup> y diciendo: Es necesario que el Hijo del Hombre padezca muchas cosas, y sea desechado por los ancianos, por los principales sacerdotes y por los escribas, y que sea muerto, y resucite al tercer día”

### II. WHAT THE FUTURE HOLD FOR HIM

#### 1. Rejection from his own

1) Jn. 1:11 <sup>11</sup> He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him” <sup>11</sup> A lo suyo vino, y los suyos no le recibieron”

#### 2. Abandonment from his friends

1) Mat 26:56 <sup>56</sup> Mas todo esto sucede, para que se cumplan las Escrituras de los profetas. Entonces todos los discípulos, dejándole, huyeron” <sup>56</sup> But this has all taken place that the writings of the prophets might be fulfilled.” Then all the disciples deserted him and fled”

#### 3. Suffering and crucifixion

1) Mat. 27:26 <sup>26</sup> Then he released Barabbas to them; and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered Him to be crucified” <sup>26</sup> Entonces les soltó a Barrabás; y habiendo azotado a Jesús, le entregó para ser crucificado”

### III. WHY DID HE DO IT?

#### 1. He came to please the Father

1) **Mat. 17:5** <sup>“5</sup> While he was still speaking, a bright cloud enveloped them, and a voice from the cloud said, “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!” <sup>“5</sup> *Mientras él aún hablaba, una nube de luz los cubrió; y he aquí una voz desde la nube, que decía: Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia; a él oíd*”

**2. He came to take our place**

1) **Is. 53:5** <sup>“5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed” <sup>“5</sup> *Mas él herido fue por nuestras rebeliones, molido por nuestros pecados; el castigo de nuestra paz fue sobre él, y por su llaga fuimos nosotros curados*”

**3. He came to give us victory**

1) **Rom. 8:37** <sup>“37</sup> Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us” <sup>“37</sup> *Antes, en todas estas cosas somos más que vencedores por medio de aquel que nos amó*”

**4. He came to give us a future**

1) **Jn. 14:2-3** <sup>“2</sup> In My Father’s house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. <sup>3</sup> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also” <sup>“2</sup> *En la casa de mi Padre muchas moradas hay; si así no fuera, yo os lo hubiera dicho; voy, pues, a preparar lugar para vosotros.<sup>3</sup> Y si me fuere y os preparar lugar, vendré otra vez, y os tomaré a mí mismo, para que donde yo estoy, vosotros también estéis*”
