

DO THIS IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME

1 Cor. 11:23-26

²³ For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, ²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." ²⁵ In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes" ²³ Porque yo recibí del Señor lo que también os he enseñado: Que el Señor Jesús, la noche que fue entregado, tomó pan; ²⁴ y habiendo dado gracias, lo partió, y dijo: Tomad, comed; esto es mi cuerpo que por vosotros es partido; haced esto en memoria de mí. ²⁵ Asimismo tomó también la copa, después de haber cenado, diciendo: Esta copa es el nuevo pacto en mi sangre; haced esto todas las veces que la bebiereis, en memoria de mí. ²⁶ Así, pues, todas las veces que comiereis este pan, y bebiereis esta copa, la muerte del Señor anunciáis hasta que él venga"

INTRO:

I. THE IMPORTANCE OF HOLY COMMUNION

1. *Never forgetting His sacrifice*

1) **Luke 22:19** ¹⁹ And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." ¹⁹ Y tomó el pan y dio gracias, y lo partió y les dio, diciendo: Esto es mi cuerpo, que por vosotros es dado; haced esto en memoria de mí"

(1) Cup symbolizes His blood that was shed for us for the forgiveness of sins

(2) Bread symbolizes His bruise body and the healing we can receive through the celebration

2. *It's for that present moment*

1) He spent time washing their feet, sharing what was going to happen and giving them a new command

3. *A moment to consider your family of faith*

1) 1 Cor 11:33 ³³ So then, my brothers, when you come together to eat, wait for each other" ³³ Así que, hermanos míos, cuando os reunís a comer, esperaos unos a otros"

(1) If someone didn't receive a cup, share yours

4. *A time of celebration*

1) "Do this in remembrance of mí" "Haced esto en memoria de mí"

5. *It's a message of His coming*

1) 1 Cor. 11:26 ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes" ²⁶ Así, pues, todas las veces que comiereis este pan, y bebiereis esta copa, la muerte del Señor anunciáis hasta que él venga"

II. THINGS TO ALWAYS TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION

1. *Keep on teaching it to the next generation*

1) 1 Cor. 11:23 ²³ For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread" ²³ Porque yo recibí del Señor lo que también os he enseñado: Que el Señor Jesús, la noche que fue entregado, tomó pan"

2. *Never participate in an unworthy manner*

1) 1 Cor 11:27 ²⁷ Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord" ²⁷ De manera que cualquiera que comiere este pan o bebiere esta copa del Señor indignamente, será culpado del cuerpo y de la sangre del Señor"

(1) If you are in sin, don't participate

3. *It is a time of reevaluation*

- 1) 1 Cor. 11:28 ^{“28} A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup”
^{“28} Por tanto, pruébese cada uno a sí mismo, y coma así del pan, y beba de la copa”
 - (1) How are you spiritually?
 - (2) Do you have any quarrels with your family of faith?
 - (3) Is there division among us?
4. How many times should we do it?
 - 1) Here at Pathway, we participate of it every 1st Sunday of the month
